Highlight Report:		

<u>Inpatient survey</u> - There has been an apparent lack of progress with implementing a number of actions from the last Inpatient Survey, which links to the wider work around culture and behaviours in the Trust. It was noted that the latest round of patient surveys is currently underway. The committee suggested that some of the issues may be addressed by the OD and culture work-stream of Improving Together, e.g. via the LiA programme.

<u>Sensitive disposal of non-viable foetus' (NVFs)</u> - The committee received an update report from the lead Chaplain in relation to sensitive disposal of non-viable foetus' (NVFs). There is a lack of progress in NEL in replicating the excellent service that is currently in place in the North Lincolnshire area. It is the committee's intention to write to NEL Council to help progress this issue.

<u>Patient stories</u> - A revised proposed framework for hearing patient stories was endorsed by the committee. Patient stories should continue to be received by the Trust Board and then greater emphasis will be placed on learning from patient stories within the operational groups with selective oversight of delivery of actions through the Q&S Committee.

<u>Strategy for the prioritisation of technology</u> – Throughout the agenda a number of issues were highlighted in relation to clinical & nursing staff accessing meaningful timely information and having a strategy for the prioritisation of technology to drive improvements in patient safety. The committee is aware that a digital strategy group is under development and is keen for that group to consult on key priorities so that clear communication can be offered to front-line staff on the prioritisation of developments.
