## Services Offered by the Children's Generic Team

- ❖ Acute Care Service offered to the patient in the home environment, this may include dressing and wound care following surgery, follow-up post discharge from Paediatric Ward, feeding issues, intravenous antibiotics at home.
- ❖ Constipation: Provide a point of call for parents to seek advice with the management of constipation and liaising with the child's consultant.
- ❖ Hep C: Provide a service for the screening of Hepatitis C (consultant referral only).
- ❖ Bloods: Home visit for bloods as requested from Specialist Treatment centres and consultants.
- ❖ Cardiac: Providing follow-up visits after cardiac surgery and liaising with Specialist Treatment Centres regarding ongoing cares.
- ❖ Renal: Monitoring of patients within the community.
- ❖ Guthrie: Home visit to obtain bloods to be sent to Regional New-born Screening Service and to deliver any positive Sickle cell and Thalassaemia results to parents.
- ❖ Home Enteral Feeders: Providing support and care for any issues surrounding enteral feeding.

This may include training for parents or carers on specific feeding devices and equipment.

- ❖ Epipen Training: given to parents, nurseries and schools and provide action plans by the consultant ( individual patient plans only)
- ❖ Sleep Studies: Provide an overnight Oximetry machine for patients. Followed up by downloading the results to be read by the child's consultant. This maybe ENT or Paediatric.
- ❖ Rheumatology: Working and liaising with Specialist Treatment centres to provide care and support in the community, including blood monitoring and training parents/carers to administer various different medications and devices.
- ❖ Joint Dietitian Clinic: Attending joint clinics with the Paediatric Dietitian planning and delivering care for children whom are home Enteral fed.

### **What do we do?**

We try to keep children out of hospital as much as possible by delivering care closer to home and helping families and carers to care for their child in the community with our support.

### **Support & advice**

The Children's Generic Community Team are committed to offering the best possible service for our users, ensuring that the needs of all children/young people and their families are met. This may include providing knowledge training or a point of contact between the patient and their Consultant or other health care professional.

### **Education**

The Children's Generic Community Team provides patient specific education and training for Nursery, preschool and schools settings.
